Who can be a Wrangler?

There are two classes of Wranglers

- Limited (WRL) under age 10
- Open (WRO) 10 and 11 years old

*The official age for the next competition season is the age he/she is on the day after the CMSA World Championship (October).

What do I wear?

The dress code for Wranglers is the same as adults - Traditional Western Cowboy style clothing.

- Western style long sleeved shirt (buttoned at the wrist)
- Cowboy style hat or helmet
- Western style cowboy boots
- Chinks or chaps over jeans
- Girls may wear a full-length dress or skirt (no sleeveless tops)

How do I go through the course?

An experienced rider will lead everyone through the stage and show you how to engage the course.

Competition Guidelines

8:30 Safety Meeting

*Wrangler safety meeting with all Wrangler competitors, parents, Wrangler Director, and Range Master will be held following the safety meeting prior to main match.

Limited Wranglers

- Engage the course but are not required to wear guns/holsters or address the targets.
- May be allowed to shoot by the Match Director, but any misses will be charged against their time.

Open Wranglers

- Wear holsters and use a non-firing replica to engage the targets.
- A minimum of a 5 target "stage" will be used for ground shooting at each match.
- Any misses will be charged against their time.

Lead line/assisted Wranglers will be assessed a 60 second score for all runs.

All Wranglers shall wear hearing and eye protection when shooting.
